

Have you noticed that CTA is gradually adopting the 24 hour Time System? Transportation in Canada, Mexico and much of the world are long since into it. Once you get the hang of it you'll find it reduces errors. Twenty Four Hour Time uses four digits to give the time in hours and minutes, and does not require use of the letters AM and PM.

Examples: 2:00 AM becomes 0200 hours

4:47½ AM becomes 0447½ hours

For PM hours (after noon) add 12 to the designated hour.

Examples: 5:15 PM becomes 1715 hours

11:07½ PM becomes 2307½ hours

The last second of the day, midnight is 2400 hours. The first second of the new day is 000001 hours. The first full minute of the new day one minute past midnight is 0001 hours.
