**Subject:** Movie Charter Train - "Ali"

**Line:** Yellow, Purple, Red, Orange

**Effective:** Friday, March 16, 2001

**Equipment:** Former CTA cars [now owned by Illinois Railway Museum] 22, 6655-6656


**Crew:**

- One Operator - Report to Howard at 1700 hours
- Two Switchmen - Report to Howard at 1700 hours
- One Rail Supervisor [R881] - Report to Howard at 1700 hours
- One CA Supervisor - Report to Howard at 1700 hours

The train will depart Skokie Yard at 1802 hours and proceed to Roosevelt/State. Crew will stage the train on the old South Incline for loading by the production company at the 1359 South State Street emergency exit. Filming will take place aboard the train between 95<sup>th</sup> and Howard. The train is authorized to use any crossover or interlocking to clear for revenue trains, reverse direction or assume a different route. Upon completion of filming, the train will return to 1359 South State Street emergency exit, alight the production company and lay up at Skokie Yard.

Operation is under the jurisdiction of Transportation Manager K501B on channel 8.
