## HERE IS HOW MOVING BACK WILL HELP MAKE YOUR RIDE ...



### ..... *Faster*

- We all save time if boarding and alighting proceed smoothly
- Two-way traffic at the front door is the biggest cause of delay in boarding and alighting
- Therefore, you can speed up your ride by moving toward the rear and using the rear door to alight

### ..... *Safer*

- To operate safely, your Operator needs a clear view of traffic approaching from his right
- You can help him maintain a clear field of vision by moving back from the area around the front door

### ..... *More Pleasant*

- It's not too pleasant to have other passengers pushing past you in a crowded aisle
- If you move to the rear, passengers who board after you won't have to push by you to find room

*So please help CTA give you a Faster, Safer, More Pleasant ride by moving to the rear of the bus whenever possible. You'll be accommodating waiting passengers, too, who are also eager to get to their destinations*
