PASSENGER NOTES:

Welcome aboard! The members of the Illinois Electric Railway Museum sincerely hope that you will find this an interesting and pleasant trip.

The schedule is designed to give you the maximum number of meets and photo stops possible. Consequently, we ask that you assist us in keeping the train on time by boarding as quickly as possible after each photo stop, especially the stops at Northbrook, West Park Avenue and the two photo stops in the streets of Milwaukee. If we can keep the train "right on the advertised" it may be possible to include several extra photo stops.

The merchandise despatch motor, or "MD", is No 229, the last four motored standard MD car on the North Shore. It is used to haul company material between the Highwood shops and the Harrison Street, Milwaukee shops. It is one of the remaining fleet of 25 built by the Cincinnati Car Company in 1922 and 1923. Also remaining are two snow plows (two motor), six sleet cutters (two motor), two wreck motors (two motor) and several demotorized way and structure cars.

In case you are in doubt as to the direction of trains mentioned in the schedule, all southbound trains are even numbered and all northbound trains odd numbered.

Finally, a few boring but very important safety rules:

1. Do not step between or in front of a moving train. When going in front of or behind a standing train pass at least 15 feet away in case it should start unexpectedly. Do not climb under or between a standing train. Climbing on or entering the cabs of the MD motor is prohibited.

2. Keep a close lookout for approaching trains. At many photo stops passenger trains will be passing at 85 miles per hour. Get off the track well in advance of these trains.
