


SNOWFLAKE SPECIAL Sunday, March 30, 2008



Join the members of the **Illinois Railway Museum** as they tour the Chicago Transit Authority's "L" lines. The trip will use Chicago's first stainless steel cars, the Budd-built 2201-2350 series, built in 1969-70. Beginning at 54/Cermak on the Pink Line, the trip will include the Pink, Green, Orange, Purple, Yellow, and Red Lines.

Departure:	9:00 am from 54/Cermak (Pink Line). Riders may also board at Outer Loop stations along Wells and Van Buren	
	starting at approximately 9:25 am, and at Roosevelt (Orange/Green Line) station at approximately 9:30 am. To board train at these stations, hold up ticket in plain view of motorman and excursion crew.	
Fare:	\$40.00 per person. Orders received after March 22 will be held for pickup at 54/Cermak. No refunds after March 22, 2008.	

Lunch: Lunch stops will be provided in the Loop.

Note: Because we are covering so many lines, the trip will conclude at 54/Cermak about 6:00 pm. We will make earlier stops upon request. The train is not wheelchair-accessible.
