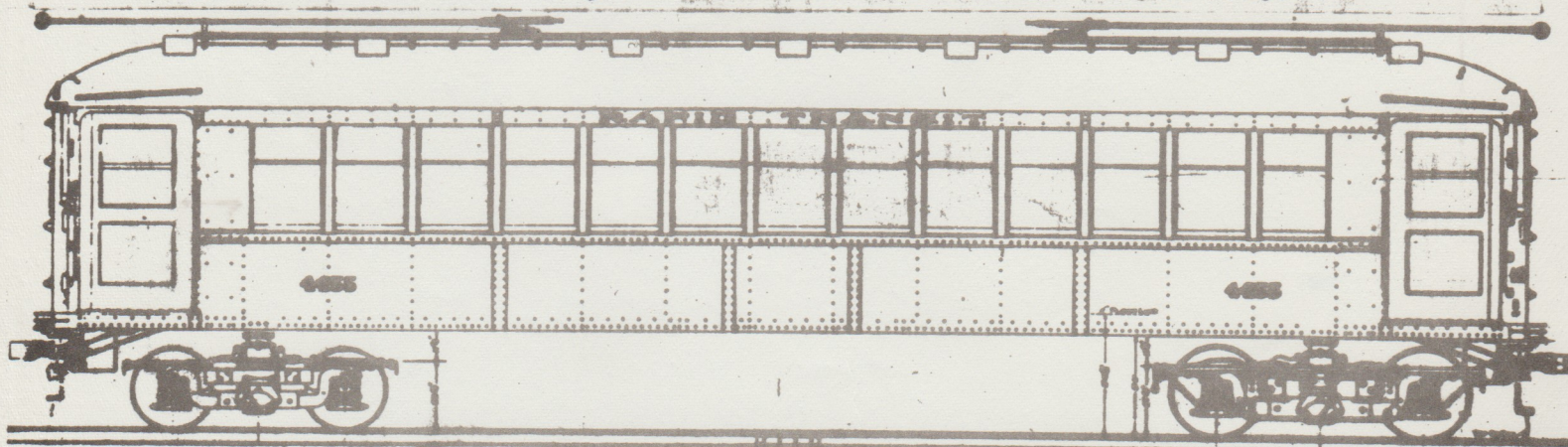


4000 SNOWFLAKE SPECIAL

Departure from the northbound North Shore Line platform

Run thru BOTH SUBWAYS - State St. and Dearborn St.

Speed run on the Congress Line to Desplaines Ave. terminal

Operation over the training track portion of the old Logan Square line and out to California Ave. on the present portion of the Logan Square (Milwaukee) route.

Full line runs to Harlem Ave., Desplaines Ave., Dempster Street

and 63rd & Ashland terminals

Lunch Stop layover in the loop
