- * Leave West Allis Station, S. 84th & W. Lapham, at 11:00 A.M., Daylight Time.
- * Ride a pre-war Pullman trolley bus over 60 miles of route, covering portions of all Milwaukee trackless trolley lines. (A 45-minute lunch stop will be made near a good cafeteria or restaurant.)
- * Visit Fond du Lac Station training track, and ride streetcar # 801. (We will spend about an hour here.)
- * Return to West Allis Station at 5:00 P.M., Daylight Time.

FARE - \$ 2.50

Proceeds from this trip will be used toward shipping Milwaukee streetcar # 972 to Illinois Electric Railway Museum at North Chicago, Illinois.

Out-of-town visitors, please note: West Allis Station is easy to reach. If you arrive on the North Shore Line, get off at National Ave. and take westbound Route 18 Vliet-National trolley bus to S. 84th and Lapham Sts. Or, in downtown area, Route 18 buses may be boarded on Plankinton Ave.
