Departure: 8:45 am. We'll boogie out of the Dempster-Skokie station on CTA's Yellow Line (Skokie Swift), at 5001 Dempster St., Skokie. You can park your Gremlin there for \$2-3 in the park-and-ride lots.

Fare: \$50.00 per person (in advance). If we get your order after March 26, we'll have your ticket ready at the Dempster-Skokie station when you get there. Only 140 tickets will be sold, and if any remain on the day of the trip, the fare will be \$55.00. No refunds after March 26, 2016.

Lunch: One hour will be given for lunch on your own at stops around the Loop; we'll even give you a list of places with good grub.

The trip will conclude at Dempster-Skokie about 6:00 pm. We will make earlier stops upon request. 2400-series cars are wheelchair accessible; consult CTA for station accessibility. **Specific equipment cannot be guaranteed and is subject to change by the CTA.**
