This new service is the most extensive improvement in Chicago's rapid transit operation methods since inauguration of through North-South service in 1914, thirty-five years ago.

It gives to the majority of the North Side rapid transit riders these important benefits—

#### FASTER SERVICE

Five minutes faster running time and fewer stops between Howard St. and the Loop.

MORE FREQUENT SERVICE

Waiting time cut in half -a train every three minutes at "all-stop" stations, from 6:30 a.m. to 6:30 p.m.

MORE CONVENIENT SERVICE

Ninety percent increase in trains, and 119 percent increase in number of seats during allexpress period from 6:30 a.m. to 6:30 p.m.
