

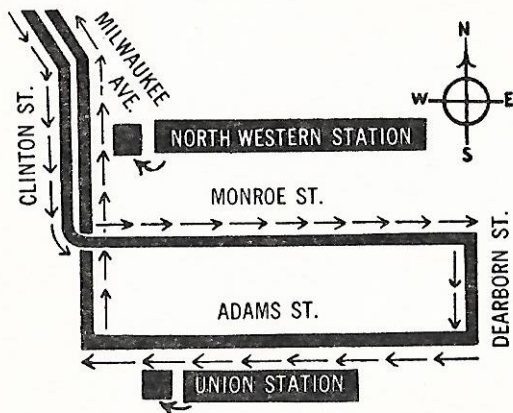


REVISE MILWAUKEE-CLINTON RUSH HOUR STREETCAR SERVICE

Beginning Monday, January 21, 1952

Milwaukee-Clinton streetcars, which have been operating to and from Van Buren and Halsted, via Clinton, during morning and evening rush hours, Mondays through Fridays, will be routed over the regular Milwaukee-Downtown line beginning Monday, January 21, 1952.

The Milwaukee-Downtown route operates over the following streets: southeast in Milwaukee to Clinton; south in Clinton to Monroe; east in Monroe to Dearborn; south in Dearborn to Adams; west in Adams to Clinton; north in Clinton to Milwaukee; and northwest in Milwaukee, as shown in the map below:



Service on the Milwaukee-Downtown route is provided by streetcars on weekdays, and by buses on Saturdays, Sundays and holidays.
