



## NEW "LIMITED" BUS SERVICE FOR NORTH AVENUE RIDERS

Beginning Monday, May 5, 1952, a supplementary bus service, making limited stops, will be inaugurated during morning and evening rush hours, Mondays through Fridays.

These "limited" buses will operate in addition to regular North Avenue trolley bus service and will serve the area between terminals at North and Grand Avenue on the west, and the Damen Avenue station of the Logan Square-Milwaukee Avenue subway, providing a convenient connection with fast rapid transit trains to and from the downtown business district.

The "limited" buses will be scheduled at intervals of 3 to 7 minutes during the following periods:

*Eastbound*—Leave Grand and North, from 6:45 a.m. to 9:30 a.m.

*Westbound*—Leave Damen "L" station from 3:50 p.m. to 6:30 p.m.

The buses will make stops as follows: *A.M. Rush (eastbound)*—Grand, Pulaski, Lawndale, Homan, Kedzie, California, Western, Damen "L" Station, and Winchester. *A.M. Rush (westbound)*—Winchester, Milwaukee (near side), Damen "L" station (far side), Grand, and Kilbourn-Grand. *P.M. Rush (eastbound)*—Grand, Damen, Winchester. *P.M. Rush (westbound)*—Winchester, Milwaukee (near side), Damen "L" station (far side), Western, California, Kedzie, Homan, Lawndale, Pulaski, Grand, and Kilbourn-Grand.
