



NEW Through Service for AUSTIN AVENUE RIDERS

Beginning Sunday, February 1, 1953, through bus service will be established on Austin Avenue between terminals at Milwaukee-Devon on the north, and Roosevelt Road on the south.

Presently CTA has two bus services on Austin, a surface system route which operates between Milwaukee-Devon and North Avenue, and a boulevard route running between North Avenue and Roosevelt Road. Passengers desiring through service on Austin, or a connection with intersecting surface routes or the Lake Street and Garfield Park "L" routes, must now make an inconvenient double transfer.

Under the new plan of operation a single route—the surface system Austin Avenue line—will be extended south to provide through service between Milwaukee Avenue and Roosevelt Road, *eliminating the necessity for a double transfer.*
