

# REVISED SHUTTLE SERVICE

EFFECTIVE  
FEB. 1, 1953

**FOR BOULEVARD SYSTEM  
IN THE CENTRAL BUSINESS  
DISTRICT**

The Boulevard System shuttle service is revised to provide additional service at reduced fare to short-trip riders in the Central Business District.

This service is on a cash fare basis which eliminates the necessity of handling commuter bus coupons.

Thru-riders of regular service are also benefited because when short-trip riders utilize the shuttle service, they do not over-tax the facilities of the regular service intended for thru-riders.



**INFORMATION CONCERNING THE REVISED BOULEVARD SYSTEM SHUTTLE SERVICE**

**FARES**

Adult fare is 10¢.

Child-student fare is the prevailing rate established for children and students on regular service routes. (Student must have identification card.)

**TRANSFER PRIVILEGES**

Passengers are entitled to receive transfers to other CTA routes only upon payment of a regular service fare.

**RAILROAD COMMUTER BUS COUPONS**

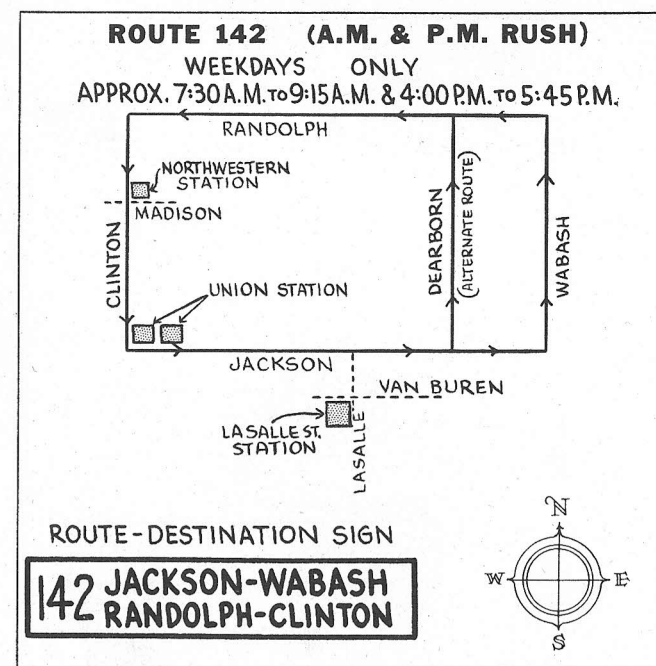
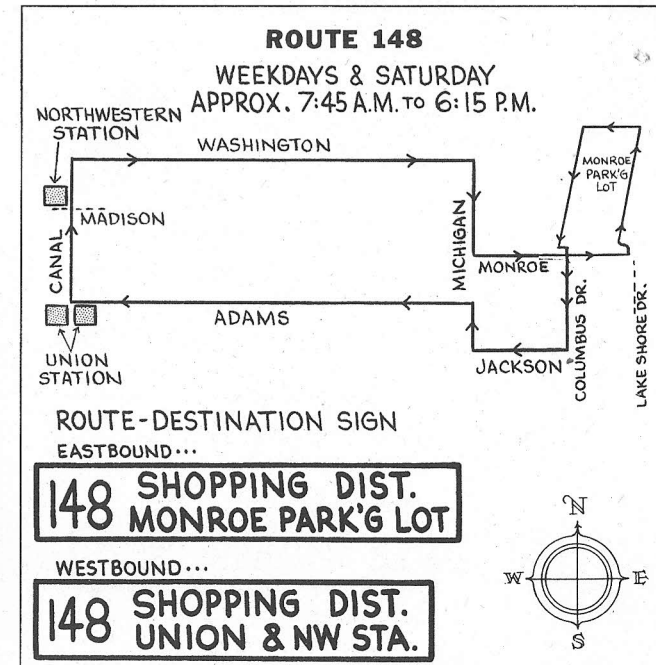
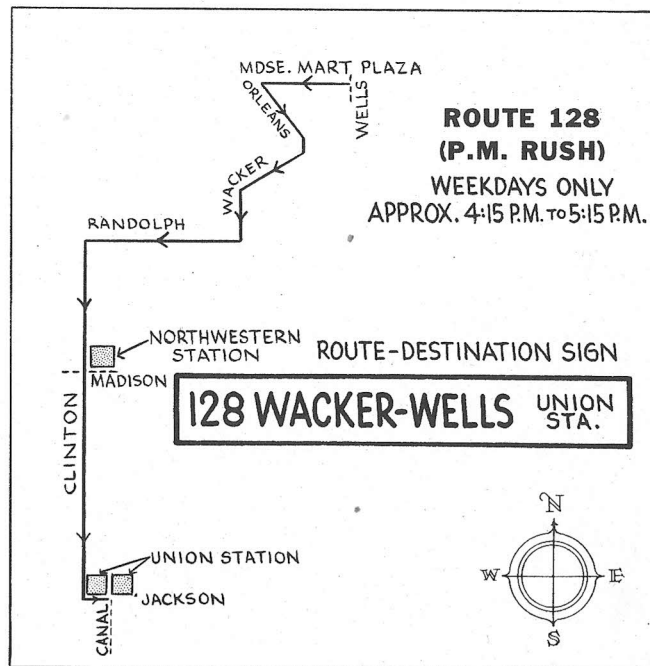
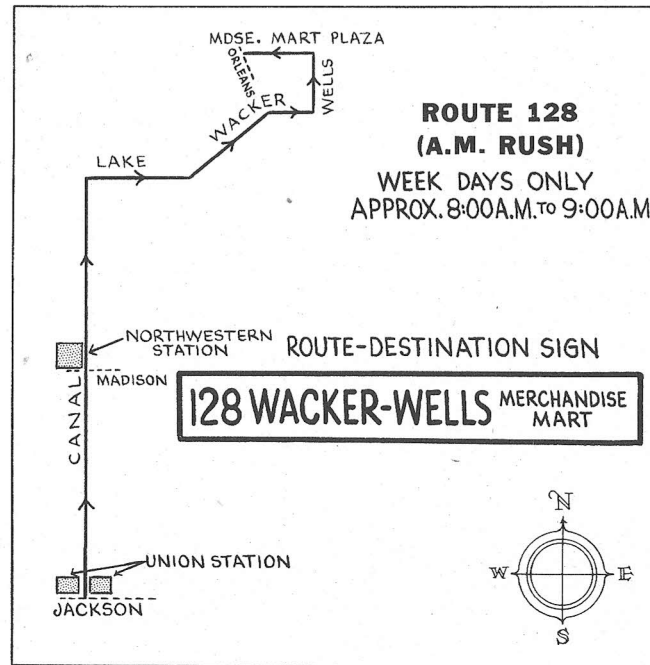
Railroad Commuter Bus Coupons are no longer accepted. Outstanding coupons will be redeemed by the issuing railroad.

**BUS IDENTIFICATION**

All shuttle buses are identified by a sign reading "10¢" which is displayed on the front of the bus.

**ROUTES**

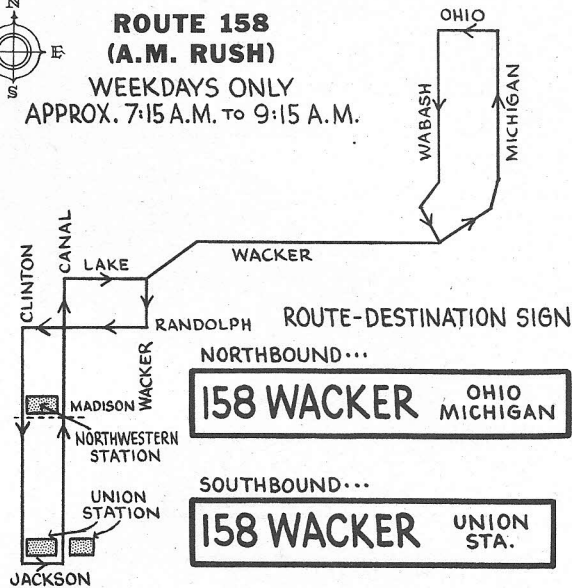
The routes over which shuttle buses operate are shown on the following pages.





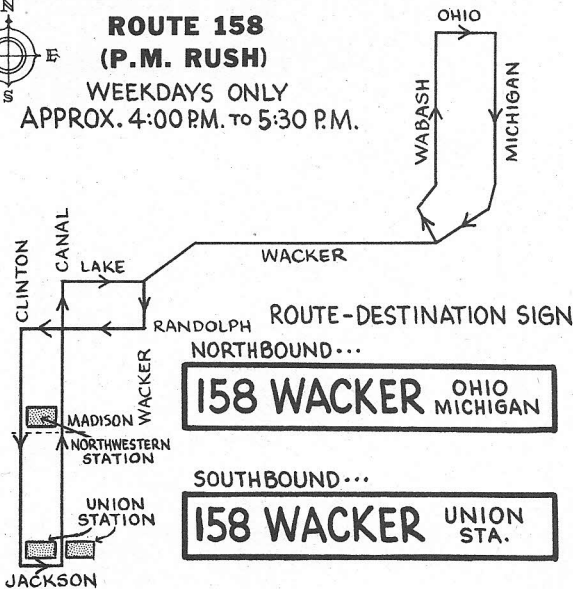
### ROUTE 158 (A.M. RUSH)
