



MODERN MOTOR BUSES FOR INDIANA AVENUE TRANSIT RIDERS

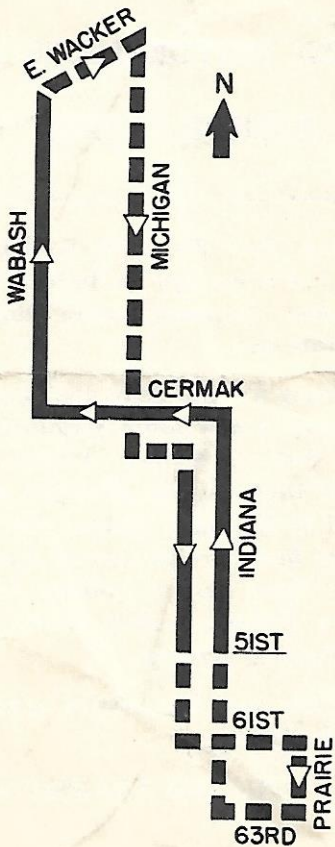
Beginning Sunday, May 24, 1953, modern motor buses are replacing old red streetcars on Indiana Avenue Route No. 38, providing more frequent service and quieter operation for riders of this line.

The modern Indiana Avenue buses are to operate north in Indiana Avenue, from a new south terminal at 63rd Street to Cermak Road, west to Wabash Avenue, and north to Wacker Drive, and then east to Michigan Avenue. From the north terminal at Michigan Avenue and Wacker Drive, the Indiana Avenue buses are to operate south in Michigan Avenue to Cermak Road, east to Indiana Avenue, south to 61st Street, east to Prairie Avenue, south to 63rd Street, and then west to Indiana Avenue.

A route map of the new bus service appears on the reverse side of this leaflet.
