BUS STOPS ON ADDISON RELOCATED

TO ELIMINATE CONFUSION, Chicago Transit Authority and the City of Chicago are relocating bus stop signs and locations along Addison Street to provide a more uniform pattern of stops and an improved system for patrons of the Addison Street bus line. This work will be started Saturday, March 14, and is expected to be completed Monday, March 16.

At present most of the bus stops are made at the far sides of intersections, but quite a few are made before the buses cross the intersection.

On Monday, March 16, all bus stop locations along Addison Street, between Lake Shore Drive and Pueblo, will be on the near side of cross streets with two westbound exceptions and seven eastbound exceptions where street arrangements and traffic patterns make it necessary to have far side stops. On CTA's Surface system, near side stops predominate.

The two locations where westbound buses will stop on the far side of the street are Lake Shore Drive and Elston Avenue. Eastbound buses will stop at the following far side locations: Lincoln Avenue, Kedzie Avenue, Central Park Avenue, Avondale Avenue, Milwaukee Avenue, Kenton Avenue and Austin Avenue.

New passenger information signs will indicate the new bus stop locations for CTA passengers. These will be double-faced, weather-proof signs in CTA colors of permanent metal construction and will give complete information on service provided by CTA at the particular locations where the signs are located.
