

PARKING AREA ENLARGED AT DESPLAINES TERMINAL

Space for parking an additional 127 automobiles at CTA's Desplaines avenue terminal in Forest Park will become available for Rapid Transit riders on or about July 7, 1960.

A new parcel of land recently purchased from Commonwealth Edison Company at a total cost of \$29,075 will provide 67 new parking spaces. This lot is on the northwest corner of Harrison street and Desplaines avenue and is directly south of CTA tracks and the present parking facilities.

Cinder surface on present grade is being installed along with bumper ties to indicate parking stalls at an additional cost of \$6,000. The entrance and exit will be at the north end of the lot and can be reached by driving west in the Public Service Company driveway from Desplaines avenue. Appropriate signs are being erected to direct patrons to the entrance.

Due to the cost of acquiring and preparing this lot for parking, a fee of 25¢ will be charged for all-day parking. The fee will be collected by an attendant at the entrance.

In addition to the new lot, the main parking lot, which is free of charge, will be enlarged to accommodate approximately 50 more automobiles. This is being accomplished by re-grading space formerly occupied by temporary tracks, and by moving construction material stored at the north and northwest sides of the lot.
