



NEW LOOK BUSES for CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY

Three hundred 50-passenger, diesel-powered NEW LOOK buses have been purchased by Chicago Transit Authority at a total cost of \$7,884,273.

The first 150 NEW LOOK buses, manufactured by the General Motors Corporation, are now in regular daily service.

The second 150 NEW LOOK buses, being manufactured by another company, are being delivered now, and delivery should be completed in December when all of them will be in regular daily service.

Attractive in design and appearance, the NEW LOOK buses are equipped with air springs, wider seats, picture-type windows, fluorescent lighting, and improved heating and ventilating systems for the maximum in passenger comfort. Powered by the latest type V-6 diesel motor, the buses are also equipped with power steering and automatic transmissions.

Including the 300 NEW LOOK buses, Chicago Transit Authority has spent or obligated a total of approximately \$157,157,000 for modernization - - \$119,463,000 for modern buses and rapid transit cars, and \$37,694,000 for three modern garages, and modernization of other facilities such as shops, existing garages, machinery and tools, and fixed transportation equipment.
