

Special CTA No. 40 buses called the "o'harexpress" are the secret.

They serve O'Hare from the CTA Transit. Center at Jefferson Park. (We show you how to get there from home on the center pages.)

to get there from home on the center pages.)
One of these buses leaves Jefferson Park
for O'Hare every 30 minutes on the hour and
half-hour (midnight to 4 a.m., it leaves hourly).

The trip takes 15 minutes. Once the bus reaches the airport, it stops at 10 different locations, taking about 10 minutes in all. Then it returns to Jefferson Park.

It's very rapid transit to and from work.
Convenient, and air conditioned, too.

Total fare from your home to O'Hare: 70¢.



How to get to Jefferson Park from home.

Getting to O'Hare via CTA is a simple two-step trip. 1) Go to the Jefferson Park Transit Center on Chicago's northwest side. Whether you take a bus or train, buy a transfer and keep it until you reach Jefferson Park.
2) Give your transfer and 15¢ exact change to the driver of the o'harexpress and ride on out to the airport. Nothing could be simpler or as cheap.

Jefferson Park station is served directly by both the Congress/ Milwaukee and Douglas/ Milwaukee CTA trains, and by nine bus lines: 56, 56A, 64, 68, 81, 85, 85A, 88, and 92.



If you don't live close to one of these direct service lines then here's the best way for you to get to Jefferson Park.

O'Hare Airport

Look at the Rapid Transit map on these pages and take the line that runs closest to you. Take a CTA bus to the line if it's convenient, but in any case buy a transfer and keep it all the way. The train you're on will take you to the Loop.

Now take a look at the Loop map. It will show you how to change from your train to the Congress/Milwaukee or Douglas/Milwaukee northbound trains that will take you to Jefferson Park.

1. Englewood, Jackson Park
Your train will become a subway
train. Get off at Jackson station
and take the stairs down to
the tunnel to the Dearborn
subway. Board any northbound
train and ride to Jefferson Park.

2. Howard

Your train will become a subway train. Get off at Washington station and take the stairs down to the tunnel to the Dearborn subway. Board any northbound train and ride to Jefferson Park.

3. Dan Ryan, Lake,
Ravenswood, Evanston
Get off at Clark/Lake station.
Get free 'L' to subway transfer
from agent on the platform.
Then go down into the subway
and board any northbound train
and ride to Jefferson Park.
