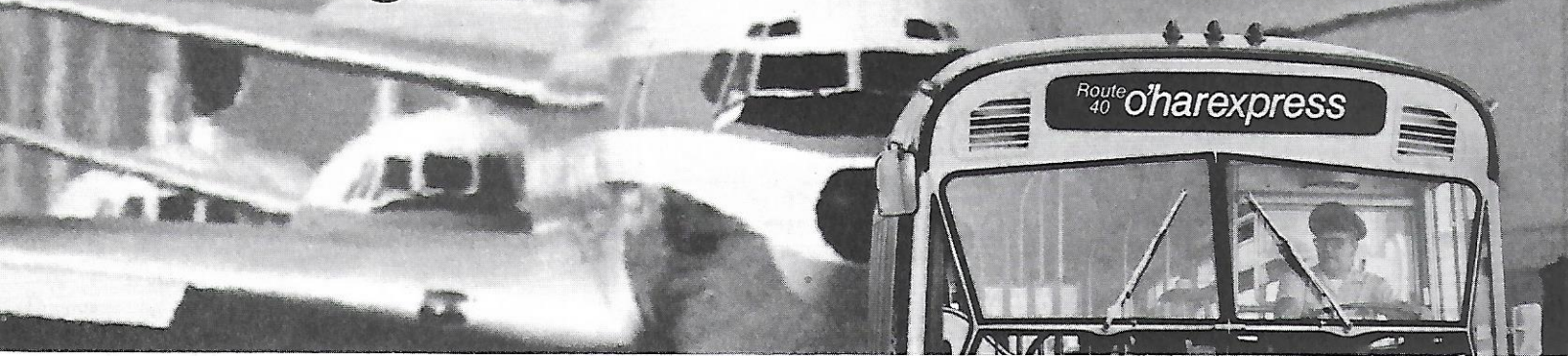


How to get to work at O'Hare for 70¢.



Special CTA No. 40 buses called the "o'harexpress" are the secret.

They serve O'Hare from the CTA Transit Center at Jefferson Park. (We show you how to get there from home on the center pages.)

One of these buses leaves Jefferson Park for O'Hare every 30 minutes on the hour and half-hour (midnight to 4 a.m., it leaves hourly).

The trip takes 15 minutes. Once the bus reaches the airport, it stops at 10 different locations, taking about 10 minutes in all. Then it returns to Jefferson Park.

It's very rapid transit to and from work. Convenient, and air conditioned, too.

Total fare from your home to O'Hare: 70¢.
