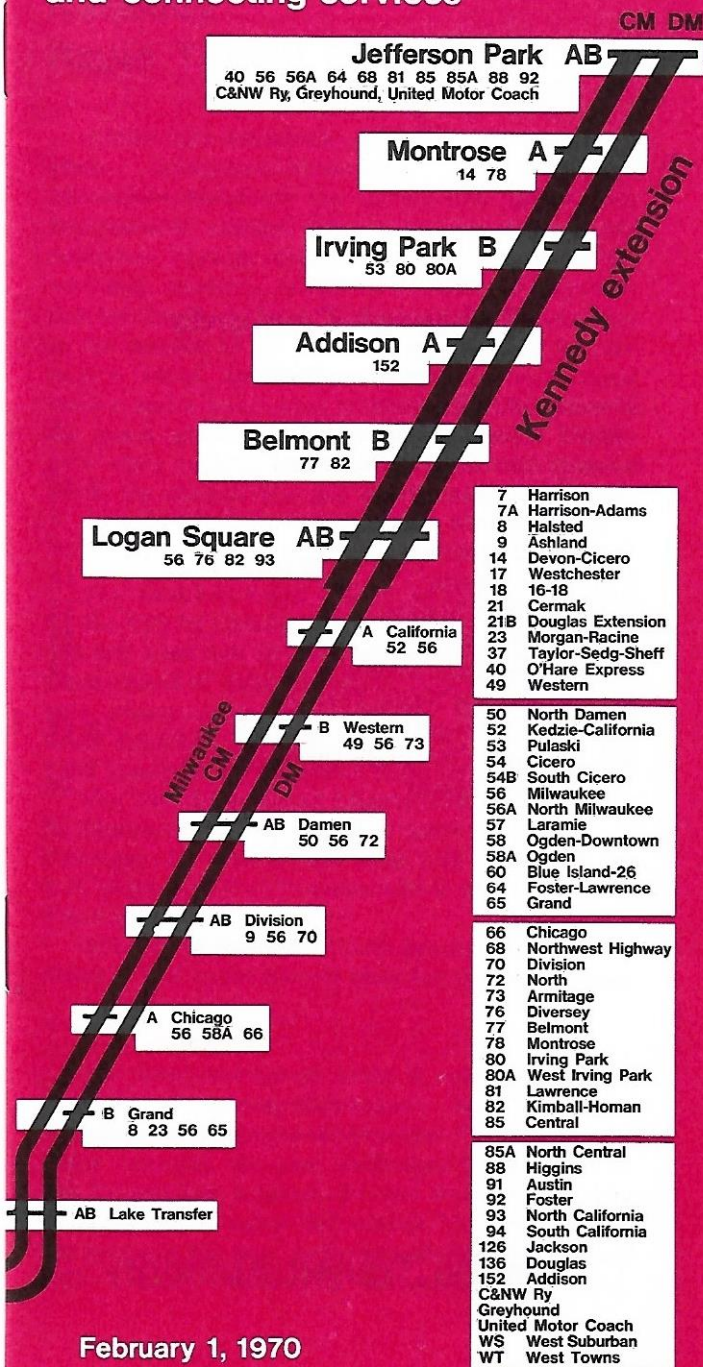
# CTA Route Map
