Be a winner yourself. Let CTA professionals chauffeur you to and from the Bears home games at Wrigley Field, either by bus or rapid transit, or to and from Dyche Stadium by rapid transit . . . no traffic "blocks" to throw you for a loss, no frantic scrimmage for parking.

If you must drive part way, leave your car at one of CTA's parking lots where there's ample capacity, and ride the rapid transit to the games.

To Dyche Stadium

For the September 27 game, regular service on the Evanston route will be supplemented by extra trains running non-stop from Howard station to Central station, conveniently located near Dyche Stadium, between 11:30 a.m. and 1:00 p.m.

To reach Howard station, board any northbound North-South train. Transfers to the North-South route may be made from other rapid transit routes and intersecting CTA bus routes. Direct connections are made at Howard with Skokie Swift trains.

After the game, extra trains leave Central station until 5:00 p.m. for non-stop trips to Howard station.

To Wrigley Field

North-South Service

Howard-Jackson Park-Englewood

TO THE GAME: Extra cars are added to the regular service operating every 5 minutes in each direction (every 10 minutes on Englewood and Jackson Park branches).

RETURNING: 8-car trains load continuously for each direction beginning at break of game and continue until all are served. Direct across-the-platform connections at Howard for Evanston-Wilmette and Skokie Swift trains.

Evanston-Wilmette Service

TO THE GAME: Linden Limiteds will be added to the regular service. Every 7½ minutes a Linden Limited departs from Linden, non-stop to Howard. Also departing is a local train, making all regular stops from Linden to Howard. Direct across-the-platform connections are made at Howard with "L"-subway trains to the game.

RETURNING: Linden Limiteds added to the regular service connect with "L"-subway trains from the game. Every 7½ minutes a Linden Limited leaves Howard for Linden non-stop, followed by a local train making all regular stops.

Skokie Swift Service

Non-stop between Dempster and Howard.

TO THE GAME: Special trains, expressly for the convenience of Bear fans, leave Dempster terminal every 7½ minutes from 11:30 a.m. to 12:40 p.m. Direct across-the-platform connections at Howard with "L"-subway trains to the game.

RETURNING: Skokie Swift specials connecting with "L"-subway trains arriving from the game leave Howard every 7½ minutes. Last Skokie-bound train leaves Howard at 5:00 p.m.
