


Make way for "The Spirit of Gicago!"



The Budd Company is delivering 300 new stainless steel rapid transit cars to the Chicago Transit Authority. The CTA purchase is funded by the U.S. Department of Transportation (80%) and the Illinois Department of Transportation (20%). All railcars in the \$133 million order are expected to be in service by 1984.

The attractive red, white and blue striped cars are designed to maximize passenger comfort and reduce CTA operating and maintenance costs.



Sliding doors provide 50 inches of clearance for boarding and alighting.

Seats have padded cushions in contoured fiberglass shells and include fold-up seats to accommodate wheelchairs. Each pair of Budd cars seats 92 persons.
