

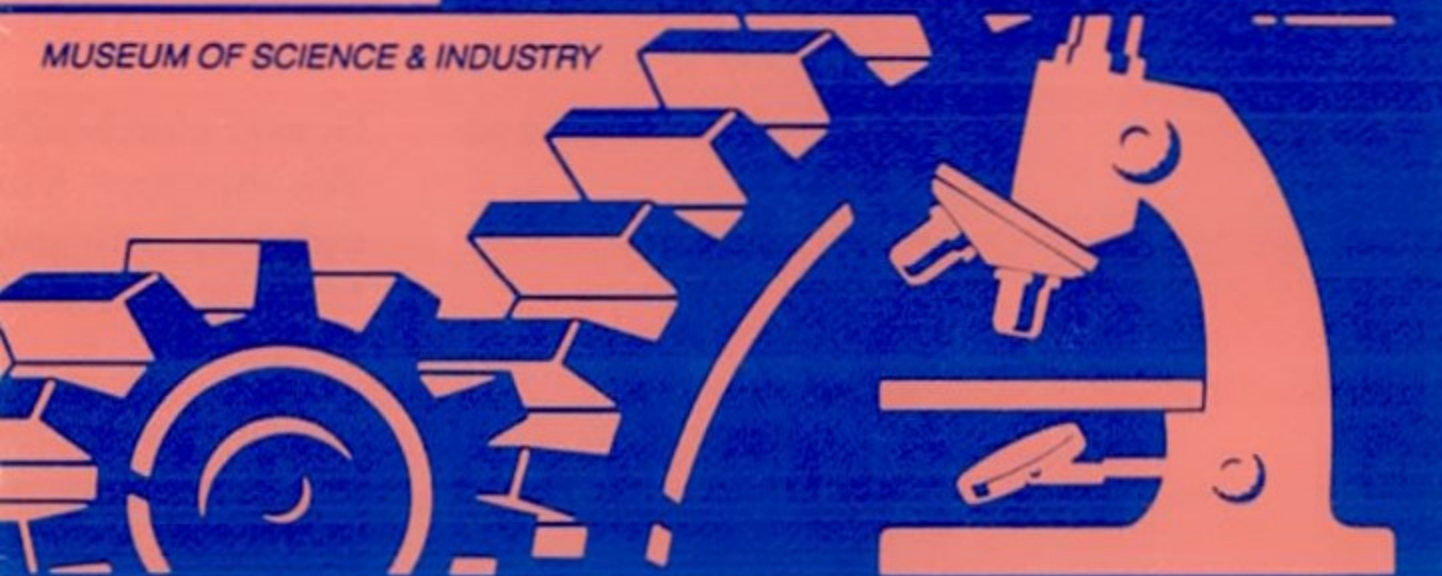

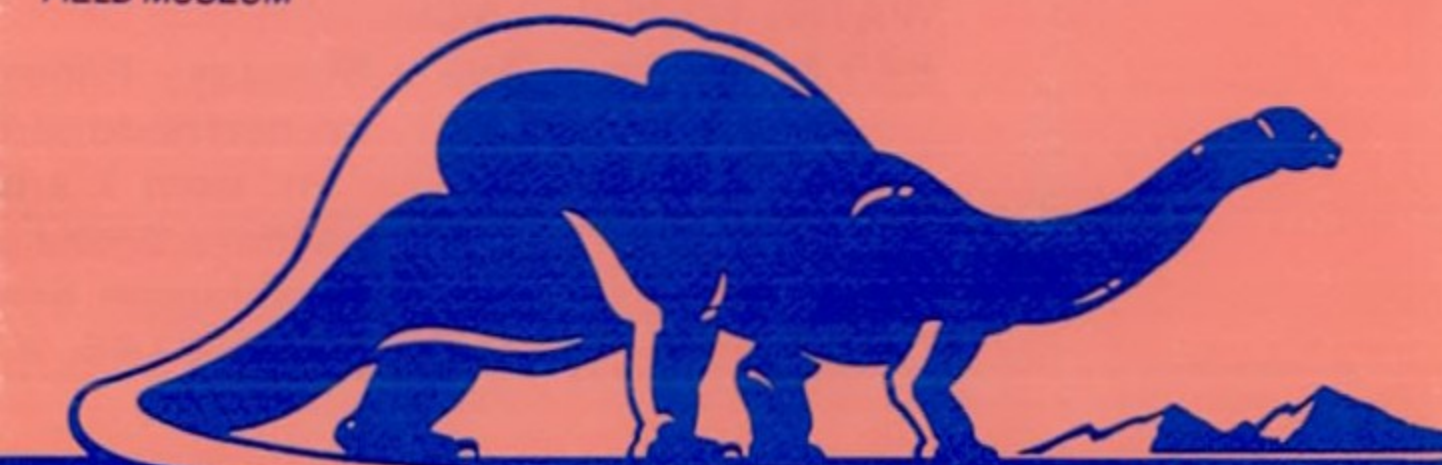

# Metra

Metropolitan Rail  
The Commuter Rail Division of the RTA.



This brochure tells you how easy it is to get to some of Chicago's most famous attractions by METRA and CTA buses and trains. It's also very reasonable with METRA's family and group fares.

**CHICAGO & NORTH WESTERN STATION**  
500 West Madison Street

**NOTE:** Return trips may not be exactly the same. One-way streets often force different return routings for many buses. Please consult the map.

**WRIGLEY FIELD-CUBS**  
1060 West Addison

Board eastbound #20, #56, #127 or #131 bus on Washington Street. Transfer at State Street, walk to subway entrance, and board northbound subway "B" train to Addison Street.

**LINCOLN PARK ZOO**

Board eastbound #20, #56, #127 or #131 bus on Washington Street. Transfer at State Street to northbound #151 bus.

**WATER TOWER PLACE**  
845 N. Michigan Ave.

Monday - Friday board a northbound #125 express bus on northbound Canal Street. (This bus operates Mon. - Fri. from 7 a.m. to 6:20 p.m. only). On weekends and holidays board eastbound #20 or #56 bus on Washington Street. Transfer at State Street to a northbound #145, #146 or #151 bus.

**STATE STREET MALL**

Board eastbound #20, #56, #127 or #131 bus on Washington Street. Get off at State Street.

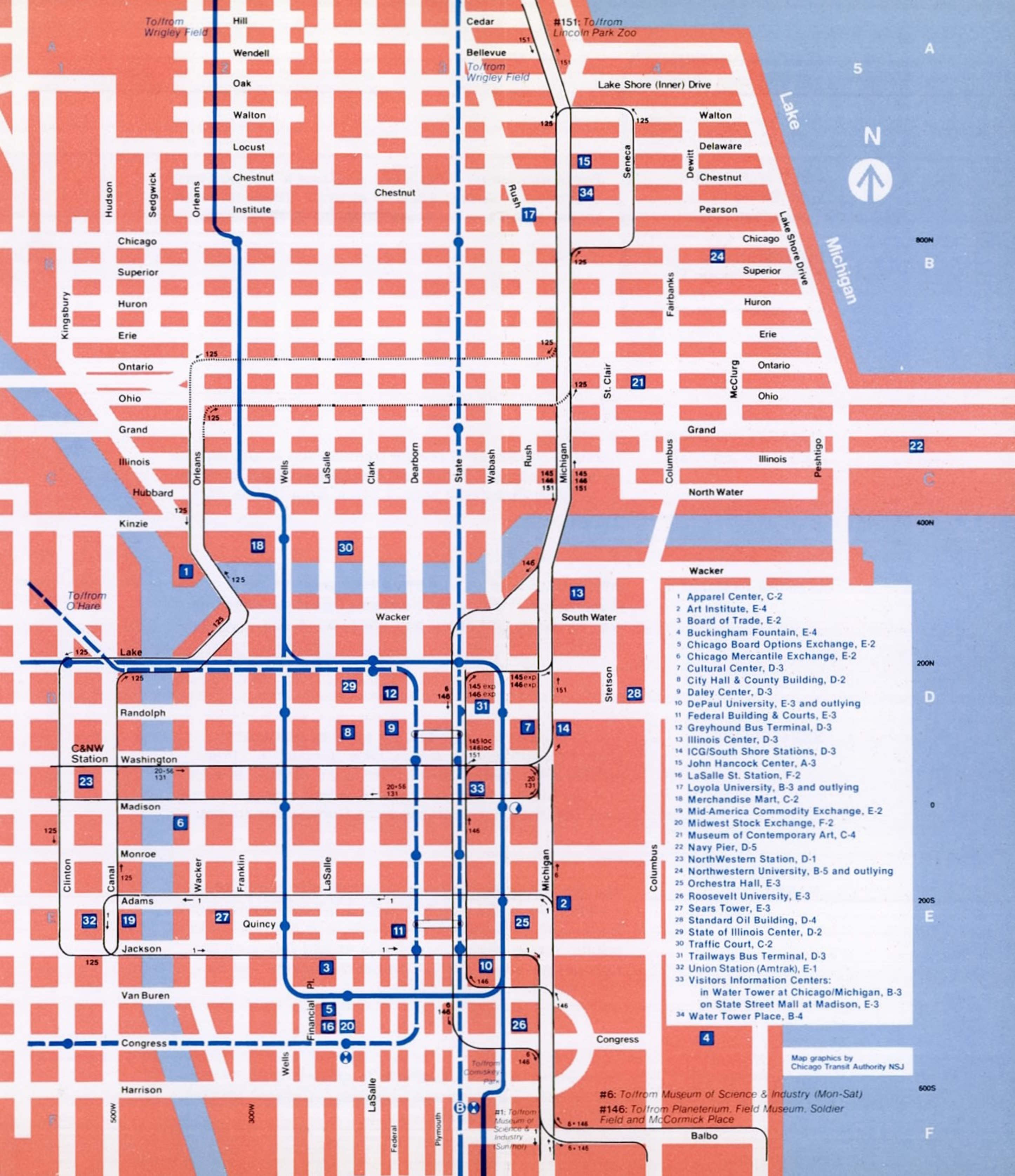
**ART INSTITUTE**  
Michigan at Adams

Board eastbound #20, #56, #127 or #131 bus on Washington Street. Ride to Michigan Avenue then walk three blocks south to Adams Street . . . or transfer to southbound #3, #4, #145 or #151 on Michigan Avenue to Adams Street.

**MUSEUM OF SCIENCE  
AND INDUSTRY**  
Lake Shore Dr. and  
57th Street

Monday - Saturday board eastbound #20, #56, #127 or #131 bus on Washington Street. Transfer at State Street to southbound #6 express bus which runs daily except Sundays. Sundays/holidays, walk 2½ blocks south on Canal Street and board #1 eastbound bus on southbound Canal in front of Union Station.

Board eastbound #20, #56, #127 or #131 bus on Washington Street. Transfer at State Street to southbound #146 bus on State Street to all these sites.

**COMISKEY PARK-SOX**  
324 West 35th St.

Take the Northwest Passage from station to the Clinton elevated platform. Board any eastbound Lake/Dan Ryan 'L' to 35th Street and walk 1 block west to Sox Park.

**O'HARE AIRPORT**

Board eastbound #20, #56, #127 or #131 on Washington. Transfer at Dearborn Street; walk to subway entrance and board any northbound subway train to O'Hare.

**SIGHTSEEING**

The #151 bus is also good for general sightseeing along Chicago's north side. CTA's famous 'L' trains provide a fascinating look at the city's skyline. In addition, on Sundays and holidays from late spring through early fall, the CTA operates three Culture Bus routes.

**SPECIAL FAMILY  
FARES**

METRA offers family fares on weekends and holidays. Children under 12 ride free with a full fare paying adult (maximum of 3 children free with each full fare paying adult). Young people 12-17 ride at half fare with full fare paying adult. METRA commuter tickets can be used for the matching full fare.

**GROUP TRAVEL**

Discounted fares are available to groups of 25 or more during off-peak hours and weekends. Contact METRA 312/322-6777 for arrangements.



## **METRA'S UNION STATION IS ALSO AMTRAK'S NATIONAL RAIL HUB.**

Historic Union Station is conveniently located on the west side of the Loop and near all the other METRA stations.

From Union Station you can take Amtrak direct to either coast, New Orleans and Canada, plus more than 30 Illinois cities.

Special rates, such as the All Aboard America Fare, family plan and round-trip excursion, make traveling on Amtrak very economical.

### **HELPFUL HINTS TO BUS RIDERS**

- (1) If you are not sure the bus you are about to board goes to your destination, don't hesitate to ask the driver.
- (2) Regular CTA bus fares are only 90 cents for adults and 40 cents for children (7-11 years of age). Exact fare is required.
- (3) If you need a transfer, please add 25 cents and ask the driver for one when you board.
- (4) Refer to map for city orientation.

RTA system maps, which cover the entire 6 county area, are sold at most newsstands.
