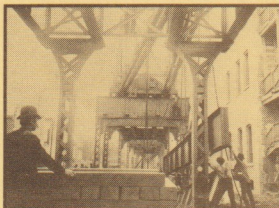

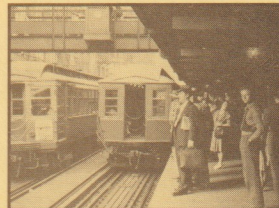

1. Connecting span raised at 35th Street, 1890.



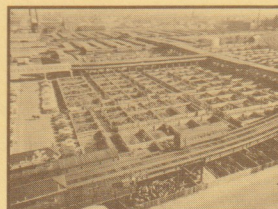
2. Overhead view of Indiana Junction, 1910.



3. Trackside view at Adams-Wabash, c. 1940.

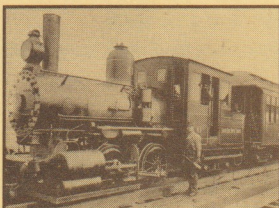


4. Ground level view of Normal Park station, 1949.

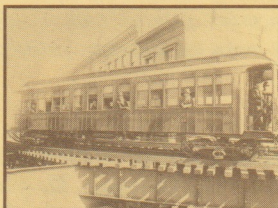


5. Single car train at Exchange station, 1952.
