You've probably seen our famous 'L' (elevated) trains in movies and on TV. Well, you can use them to get to the ballparks, the airports, nightlife, or just take a ride. And our buses take you right to the doors of museums, the lakefront, neighborhoods and attractions all over Chicago.

CTA's new 1-day visitor pass

It's the best travel value to see Chicago. Our buses and elevated/ subway trains serve the entire city and nearby suburbs, every few minutes, every day. And with this pass, your fare is already there--- for any route, in any direction, at any time.

It's simple to get...

Anyone can buy it at the locations shown below. Buy it the day you need it, or in advance, because the card is not activated until your first use!

It's easy to use...

Just insert and remove in any CTA bus farecard machine or train station turnstile. Board as often as you like for 24 hours after the first use. The card cannot be shared or recharged.

It's handy to have...

Pick up a few in advance for when company comes....or when you're ready to explore....or any time you have to make several trips!
