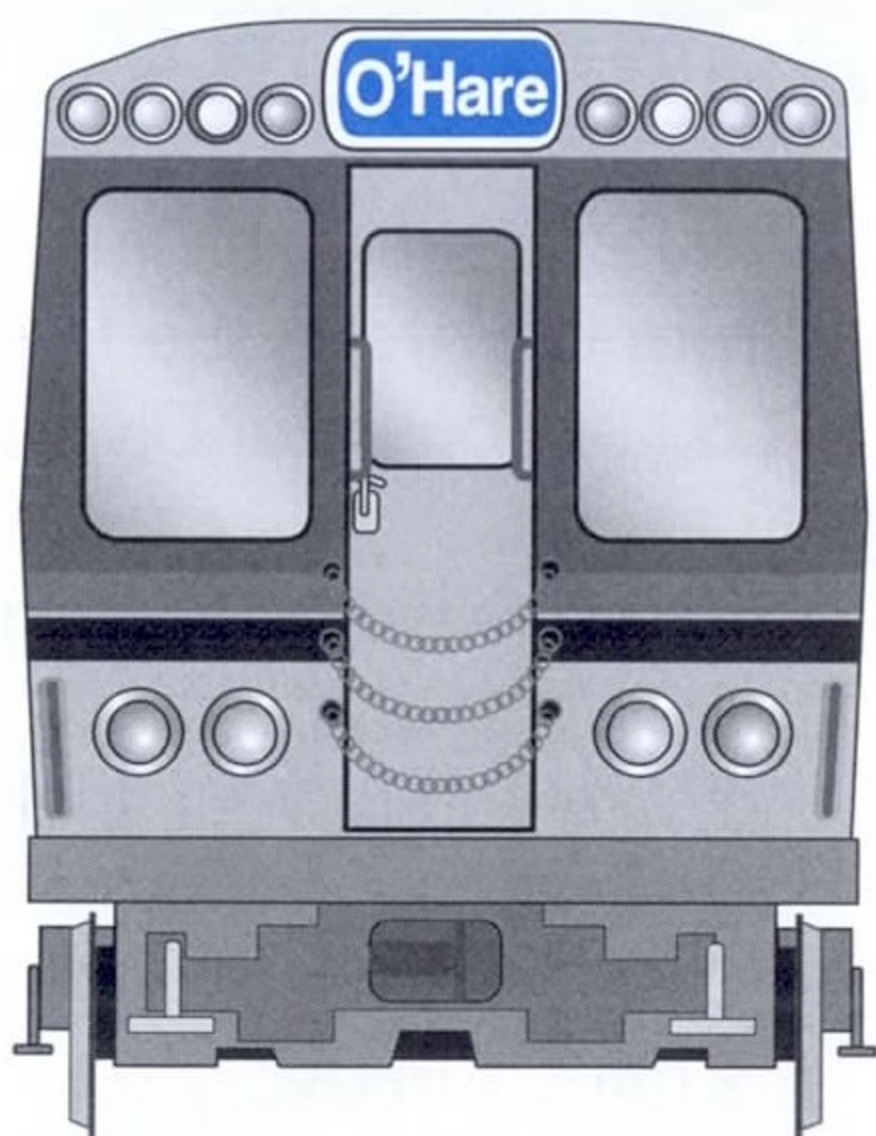

### Program Features

- ◆ You can ride the Blue Line Train from O'Hare to the Irving Park, Logan Square or Division stations.
- ◆ Taxi cabs will be waiting for you when you come out of the station to take you to your final destination.
- ◆ Blue Line trains run 24 hours. Trains run every 5 to 10 minutes thru late evening. Cabstand hours are 10 am to 12 midnight, daily.



Accessible service is available at Clark/Lake station downtown.

**From the airport:** You can count on the Blue Line Train's frequency of service and speed. This can help you avoid heavy and unpredictable expressway travel times.

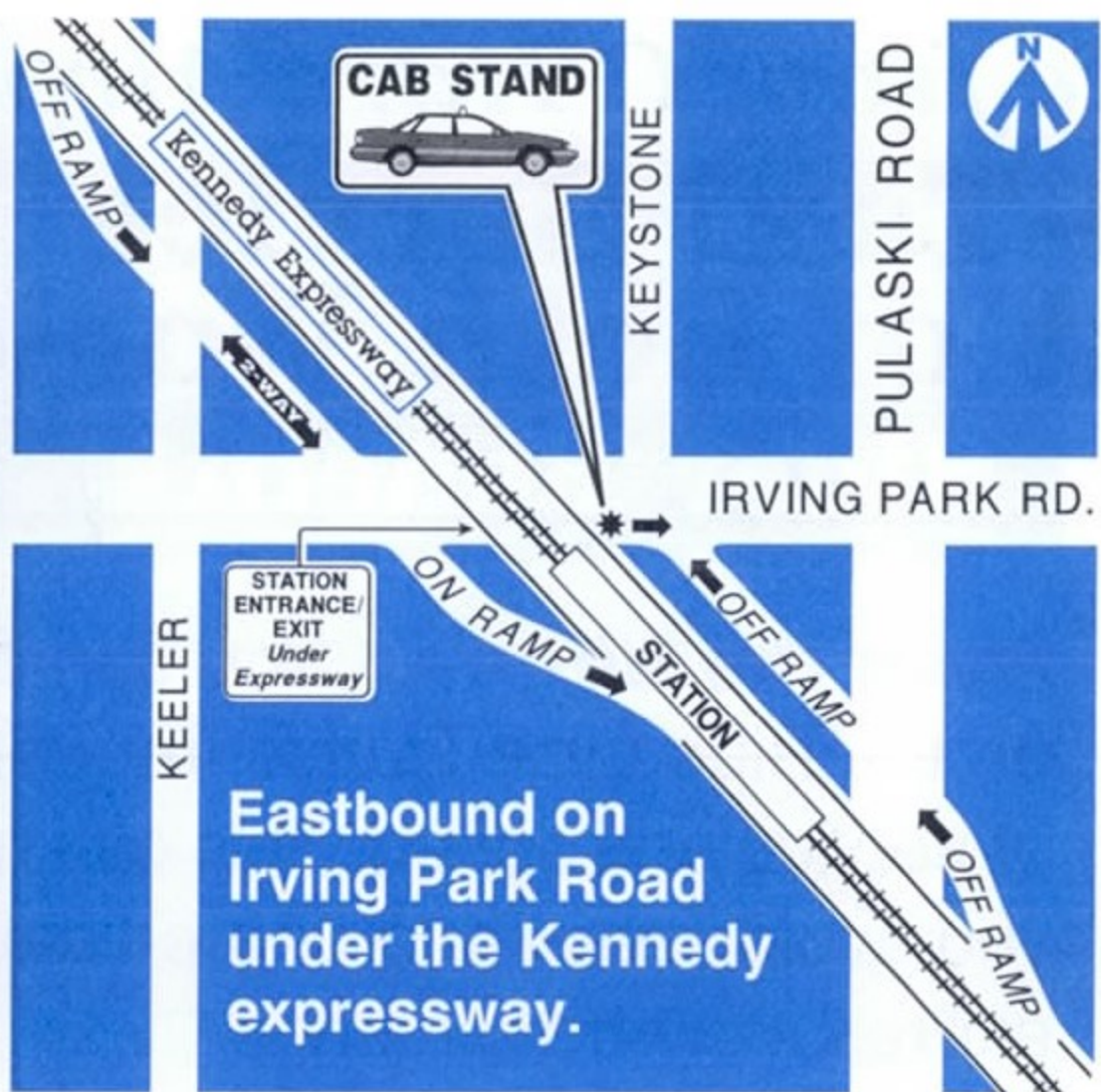
**From the station:** You can catch a taxi cab for direct, speedy service on local streets. You'll avoid downtown traffic or having to make a transfer in a congested area.

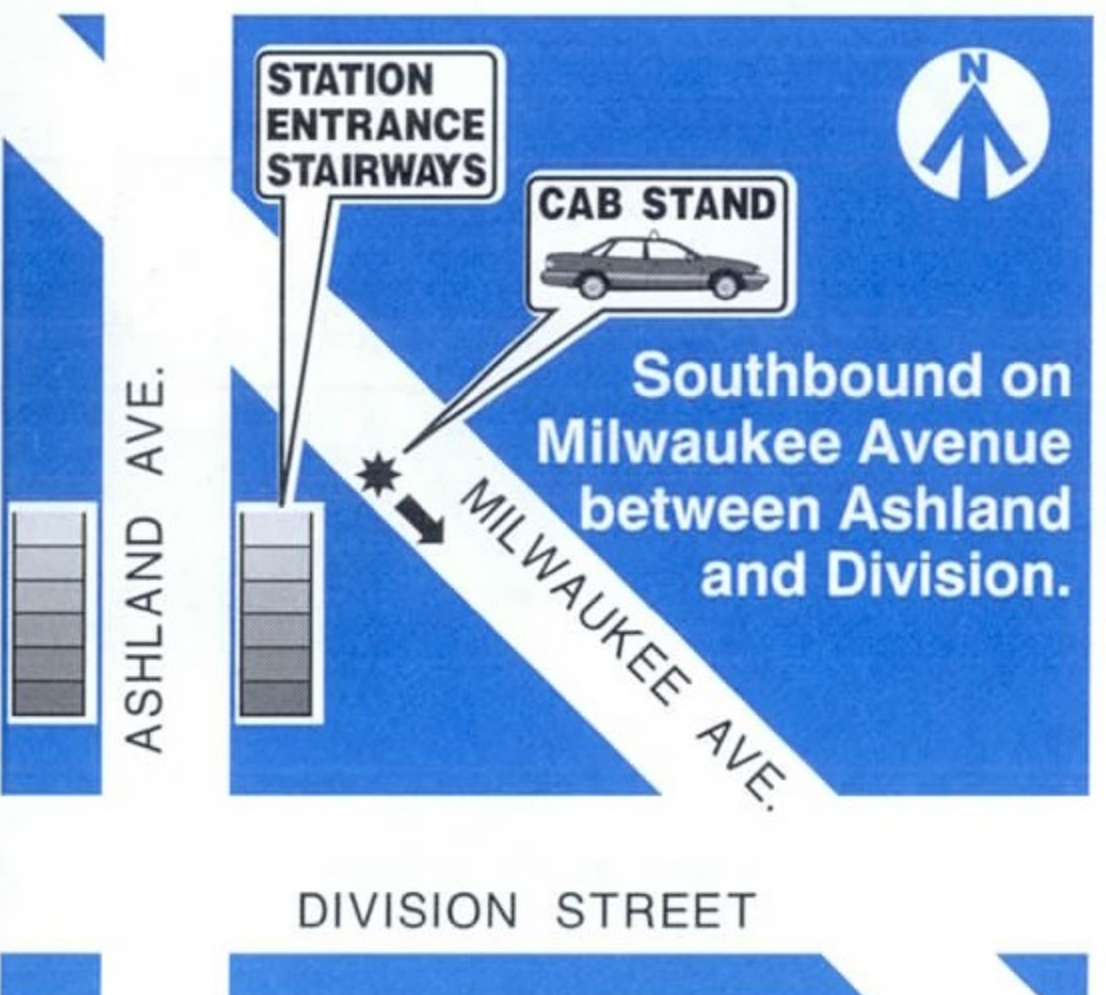
Eastbound on Irving Park Road under the Kennedy expressway.
