Tickets for the Loop Tour Train are free and available at the Chicago Office of Tourism Visitor Information Center in the Chicago Cultural Center, 77 East Randolph Street at Michigan Avenue. Please obtain tickets in advance on the day of the tour only. They are issued on a first-come, first-served basis. Tickets may be used on Saturdays at the time indicated on the tickets. The Visitor Information Center in the Chicago Cultural Center opens at 10 a.m. on Saturday. Tours depart from the Randolph/Wabash station.

The Loop Tour Train is wheelchair accessible. Please make arrangements when the tickets are picked up. The train can be scheduled to stop at the fully accessible Clark/Lake CTA station.
