Washington (Red Line) Subway Station Closure

Construction to modify the State Street subway platform for connecting tunnels and tracks that will link the Red and Blue Line subways and connect them to the planned rapid transit station at 108 N. State Street begins 12:00 midnight, Monday, October 23, 2006 through Fall 2008.

While the work is underway, the following closures will go into effect:

- The Washington (Red Line) subway station platform and the Washington-Madison/State mezzanine (between Washington and Madison) will close. Red Line trains will operate express between the Monroe and Lake subway stations during construction.
- The transfer tunnel connecting the Washington (Red/Blue) subway stations will be closed.
 For a free connection, use the transfer tunnel located between the subways at Jackson &.


To board Red Line trains, please use the other Red Line subway entrances on State Street (see other side). Customers needing elevator access should use the Jackson & (Red Line) subway station.
