

SENIORS RIDE FREE PROGRAM

To take advantage of the Seniors Ride Free Program, you must:

- Be at least 65 years of age.
- Be a resident of the six-county region (Cook, DuPage, Kane, Lake, McHenry and Will).

- Present a Senior Reduced Fare Card issued by the Regional Transportation Authority (RTA) on CTA buses and at CTA rail stations.

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CTA Refund Information

If you are eligible for the Seniors Ride Free Program and still have money on CTA farecards (SmartCard Senior Permits, Magnetic Senior Permits, and Reduced-Fare Transit Cards) you are eligible to have that money refunded.

The CTA encourages you to first use your balance before March 17th.

Cash refunds and check applications will be available at CTA headquarters, at 567 W. Lake, beginning on March 17 through July 1, 2008 between 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Please note: You must bring your current Senior Reduced Fare Card to get a refund.

Cash Refunds will be given to eligible seniors on the day you visit. If you choose to receive a check, it will be mailed to you within three to four weeks from the date you visit.

If you cannot visit CTA headquarters, the City of Chicago Department on Aging Regional Senior Centers will also be accepting applications for check refunds on select dates and locations. Call 1-888-YOUR-CTA for specific information.
