Blue Line Dearborn Subway Track Project

Work to finish track upgrades in the Blue Line Dearborn Street Subway, between the Division and Clinton stations, continues with a new project funded by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act.

Temporary closures will occur along sections of the subway most weekends through the end of 2009. Bus service will substitute for rail service between affected stations. Expect delays and allow extra travel time.

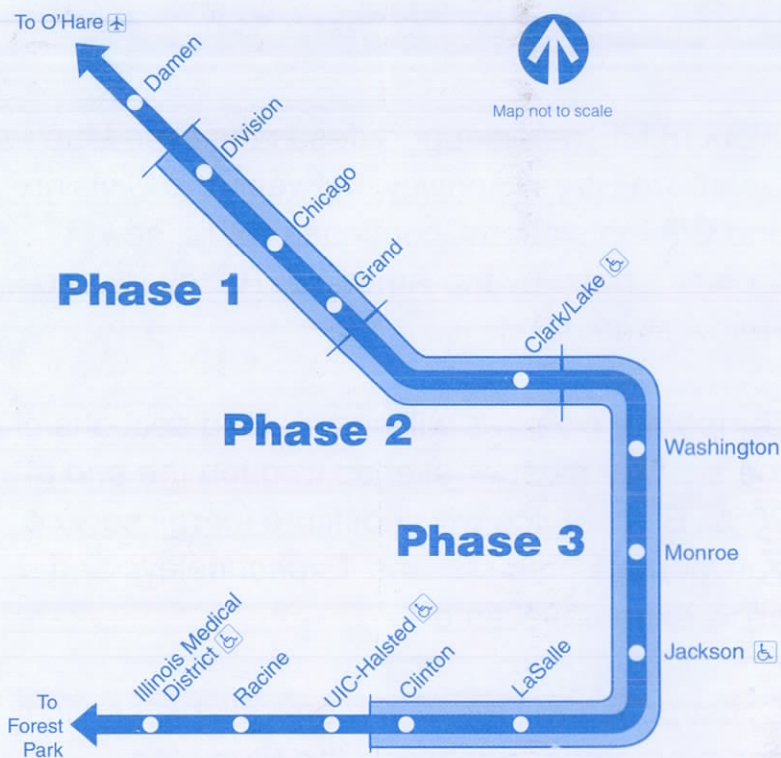
Construction will result in more reliable service and a smoother ride along the Blue Line.

Additional improvements to the Dearborn Subway will be completed in early 2010, with most work occurring during overnight hours. The project will be completed by spring 2010.

Phase 1:

Division to Grand, April thru summer 2009

Phase 2:

Grand to Clark/Lake, summer thru fall 2009

Phase 3:

Clark/Lake to Clinton, fall thru the end of 2009
